**Deadlines for application:** Applications must be postmarked by August 8, 2018. There is a late fee of \$15 after Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>.

## Overview

Space is limited. An 8' x 3' table will be provided and approximately 8' x 6' of space. Artists may share a space. You may bring your own table if preferred. All items, including space for you to sit or stand, must fit in your 8' x 6' space.

We will have a separate area for large pieces that will be displayed together, if they do not fit comfortably in the area around your table. Artists may provide their own display equipment such as lights and stands. No refund of table or registration fees after October 10, 2018.

If you do not have a City of Seattle Business License, a \$10

fee includes you under ATNW's Trade Show License.
